Just as in previous years, we will be selling a number of orchids in

As mentioned on the previous page, there are a few changes this year for society members participating in the Flower & Garden Show. The new rules are listed below.

- 1. Members who are assisting with set-up must check with the show manager prior to starting. As in past years, park behind the building to unload.
- 2 Parking: This is perhaps the biggest change from last year. We will not be permitted to park behind the building as we have in previous years. If you are scheduled for Thursday (3/15) or Friday (3/16), enter at Gate 2. If you are scheduled to work on Saturday (3/17) or Sunday (3/18) enter at Gate 6. Have your exhibiter badges in view.
- 3. Members MUST have their badges to get in—these are the only recognized form of ID for the show.
- 4. We can no longer enter via the loading dock as in previous years. Members must use the main entrance in the front of the building, and badges will be required to get in.

WE NEED YOUR BLOOMING ORCHIDS!

Key to our successful participation in the Flower & Garden show is an eye-catching display full of blooming orchids! A good display will bring visitors to our booth and promote interest in our club! And we NEED new members! If you have orchids to donate to the display, please contact either Dave Ditz (635-8148) or Bok He Nostrant (638-8273) in the Baldwinsville area, or Jeff Stuart (471-1404) in the Syracuse area. Make sure to label your plants with your name, or at least include a list.

ORCHID SALES: The club will be selling a selection of various orchids to the public from Frier's Orchids and A&P Orchids, just as in past years. It is extremely important that all sales include a duplicate receipt for our records. Each sale should also include a culture sheet and a brochure about the society. Instructions will be provided at the booth. Members are of course welcome to purchase.


