- ~ Plant Name
- ~ Parentage if a Hybrid
- ~ How long have you owned the plant?
- ~ Mini Catt? (must be under 10" tall excluding the flower spike)
- Flower color (mostly for Catts, Paphs, and Phals)
- ~ Grown under lights? Greenhouse? Windowsill?

If you have any questions, please email me and I can help you out. If your plants were grown on a windowsill, please designate which one you want to be your entry for Best Windowsill Plant judging. After I have looked over your list, I will most likely email you back to confirm and go over any other info I need.

Plants may be dropped off at the show team members houses. Please contact that member to set up drop off date. Plants will be needed by Thursday, March 31st.


